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HIGHLIGHTED UPDATES

1. Extending term for payment of corporate income tax and value-added tax

The above content is provided for in Circular No. 83/2012/TT-BTC dated 23 May 2012 of the Ministry of Finance providing guidelines for the implementation of exempting, reducing and deferring a number of sources of the State budget revenue under Resolution No. 13/NQ-CP dated 10 May 2012 of the Government on a number of solutions for removing difficulties in production and trade as well as supporting the market ("Circular 83").

Circular 83 stipulates:

- (i) 6-month extension of term for payment of Value-Added Tax ("VAT") payable in April, May and June 2012 (excluding VAT in importing part) by small and medium enterprises; enterprise operating in field of production and processing, which pay VAT in accordance with tax credit method. The term to pay VAT for April 2012 latest is by 20 November 2012. The term to pay VAT for May 2012 latest is by 20 December 2012. The term to pay VAT for June 2012 latest is by 21 January 2013.
- (ii) 9-month extension of term for payment of Corporation Income Tax ("CIT") payable in the year 2010 and earlier that have not been paid to the State Budget before 10 May 2012 by small and medium enterprises; enterprise operating in field of production and processing and enterprises in mechanical capital good manufacturing, waterway transportation. These enterprises must pay the extended tax payment by 1 October 2012.
- (iii) 9-month extension of term for payment of CIT payable in the year 2011 that have not paid to the State Budget of enterprise in mechanical capital good manufacturing, waterway transportation, steel, cement production; small and medium enterprises in real estate. These enterprises must pay the extended tax payment by 2 January 2013.

In addition, Circular 83 provides reduction of 50% of land rentals payable in the year 2012 for economic organizations, enterprise operating in trade, services those rent land and have to pay land rentals annually to the State Budget; extension of term for payment of land rentals maximum to 12 months from the date of 10 May 2012 for economic organizations being project investors those have to pay land rentals under the notice of tax authority or decision of competent authority, but have not paid or paid enough yet until 10 May 2012.

Circular 83 takes effect on 23 May 2012; the contents guided in the former legal documents that fail to comply with Circular 83 will be implemented in compliance with the guidance of Circular 83.

2. Maximum limiting conversion of rice cultivation land into non-agricultural land

The above policy is stipulated by the Government at Decree No. 42/2012/ND-CP dated 11 May 2012 on rice cultivation land utilization and management ("Decree 42").

Pursuant to Decree 42, the Government minimizes the conversion of water rice cultivation land into non-agricultural land; only allows the conversion of water rice cultivation land into land used for purpose of national defence, security, national interests and public benefits, and this conversion must be assessed and approved by the competent State management agencies.

Thereof, the Government allows the conversion of using purpose of:

(i) Water rice cultivation land

Water rice cultivation land allowed to transform its using purpose to other using purposes needs to meet criteria:

- (a) Complying with the approved land planning and land utilization plans, and being allowed by competent state management agencies;
- (b) Having the maximum saving land utilization plan, which was reflected in the overall presentation of the projects assessed and approved by competent state management agencies; and
- (c) The organizations and individuals that have been allocated or leased by the State the water rice cultivation land to utilize them as non-agricultural land must have the plan of using surface soil and compensating the water rice cultivation land area lost due to the conversion of using purpose in accordance to the current regulations.

(ii) Other rice cultivation land

Other rice cultivation land allowed to transform its using purpose to other use purpose needs to meet criteria:

- (a) Conversion of other rice cultivation land into land for planting annual crops must comply with the plan of converting structure of crop plants in localities and it fails to affect the purpose of rice cultivation in the future;
- (b) Conversion of other rice cultivation land into land for planting perennial crops, breeding, and aquaculture must comply with the approved land planning and land utilization plan and be allowed by competent State management agencies;
- (c) Conversion of rice cultivation land into non-agricultural land needs to meet the criteria that are the same as the conversion of using purpose of water rice cultivation land.

The People's Committee of the commune has the authority to decide on the conversion from other rice cultivation land's using purpose to land for planting perennial crops. The People's Committee of the province or city under the Central authority has the authority to decide on the conversion of using purpose of water rice cultivation land and other rice cultivation land (except conversion of land use purpose into land for planting perennial crops). However, before giving any decision, these authorities must report to the Ministry of Natural Resources and Environment and the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development for consideration and submission to the Prime Minister.

Decree 42 comes into force on 1 July 2012.

3. Short-term lending in foreign currency allowed to resident borrowers

On 2 May 2012, the State Bank's Governor promulgated Decision No.857/QD-NHNN regulating short-term lending in foreign currency by credit institutions and foreign banks' branches to resident borrowers ("Decision 857").

According to Decision 857, credit institutions and foreign banks' branches licensed to provide foreign exchange services, are entitled to consider and decide to provide short-term loan in foreign currency to resident borrowers who have demand for capital to implement their plans of business and manufacturing of goods for export via Vietnam's border-gates and who are able to repay the loan in foreign currency from export earnings.

When the credit institution or foreign bank's branch disburses loan to the borrower, the borrower must sell the foreign currency loan proceeds to the lender by way of a spot foreign exchange transaction, unless allowed by law to use loan proceeds in foreign currency to pay for eligible transactions.

Decision 857 came into effect from 2 May 2012 until the end of 2012.
